Participation by the Public

Title 1 Parent Involvement

The board of school directors supports active parent involvement and parent participation in the education of their children through all district programs, including the Title 1 federally-funded remedial program. The district will implement this philosophy in the Title 1 program through a variety of specific activities including but not limited to the following:

1. Provide for regular meetings of parents to formulate parent input into the program if the parents desire.
2. Inform parents of parental involvement requirements and other relevant provisions.
3. Assess annually, through parent consultation and written surveys, the effectiveness of the parental involvement program and policy, and determine what action needs to be taken, if any, to increase parental participation and program improvement.
4. Provide reasonable support for parental involvement activities as requested by parents.
5. Provide information, programs, and activities for parents in a language and format that the parents understand.
6. Convene an annual meeting to which all parents of participating children are invited.
7. Provide parents with training opportunities and materials to help them work with their child to improve academic achievement.
8. Provide parents of participating children with reports on their children's progress; where practical, conduct parent-teacher conferences, make education personnel accessible to parents, and permit parents to observe Title 1 activities.
9. Provide parents with timely information about the program.
10. Coordinate Title I parental involvement activities, as appropriate, with other parent involvement programs.
