The Support Services Committee met on Monday, November 25, and discussed the following:

- The General Nash Elementary School Additions and Renovations project is now closed out with the approval of a Credit Change order of \$21,000 from the General Contractor on tonight's agenda. All contractors have satisfied their obligations and final payment has been disbursed or will be approved for payment this evening.
- Inglewood Elementary School Additions and Renovations are substantially complete. Three Change orders were discussed for this project and appear on tonight's agenda for Board Action.
- At Oak Park, a change order to the mechanical contractor for the Natural Gas Conversion project was discussed and moved to tonight's agenda for Board action.
- The final design of the Hatfield Elementary School Additions and Renovations was discussed at the last Board Work Session. The Committee and Administration recommend that PlanCon Part F be approved for this project and submitted to PDE for approval. This will allow us to go out to bid for this Project in January 2014.
- A proposal for Closed Captioning for NPTV was discussed by the committee and recommended move forward.
- The administration reported on the status of the NPHS Camera upgrade and the Security Fencing project, as well as updates on Energy Efficiencies and Projects.
- The administration recommended several Capital Projects to be considered for the 2014-15 School Year. The recommendation was moved to the Finance Committee.
- The Committee recommends approval of the change orders and NPHS Security Fencing Bid Award on tonight's agenda and approval of PlanCon Part F for the Hatfield Renovations and Additions Project.
